**Welcome Center:** Please stop at the Welcome Center in the Narthex and check out the information available about our congregation and ministry.

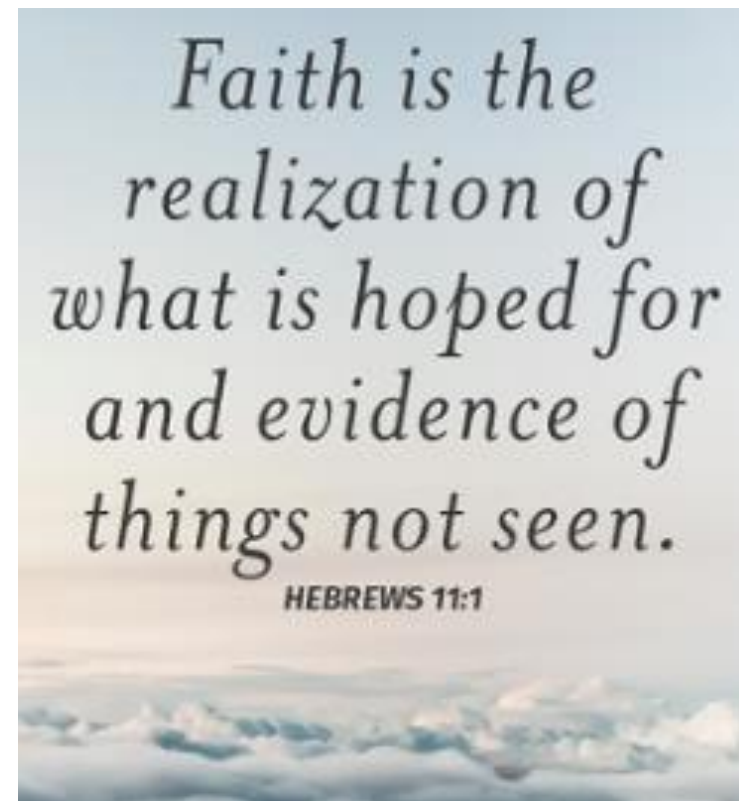

- One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip only)
- Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
- One 30-centimeter 12" ruler
- One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers—removed from the package
- One box of 24 crayons (only 24)
- One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight, solid colored canvas bag with cloth handles (no logos). No reusable shopping bags or backpacks, please.

All items must be packed inside of the cloth bag.

**From the Introduction:**

“There is such a thing as supra-human evil, and to challenge it will negate the Christian not just in thinking and acting but in what we can only call spiritual warfare. Paul offers the Christian the necessary defense, and the necessary weapons, to go about the task.” The enemy of sin and death was a power Paul recognized and provided instructions for those who had enlisted in the cause of the Kingdom. “Then comes the end when he hands over the kingdom to God the father after he has destroyed every ruler and every authority and power.” Given this metaphor and its importance in the New Testament scriptures we believe it is appropriate to use the Regime Change metaphor that is part of our language today to describe the cosmic and individual conflict that we face, as we continue to pray, “Your kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven...”
