Welcome Center: Please stop at the Welcome Center in the Narthex and check out the information available about our congregation and ministry.

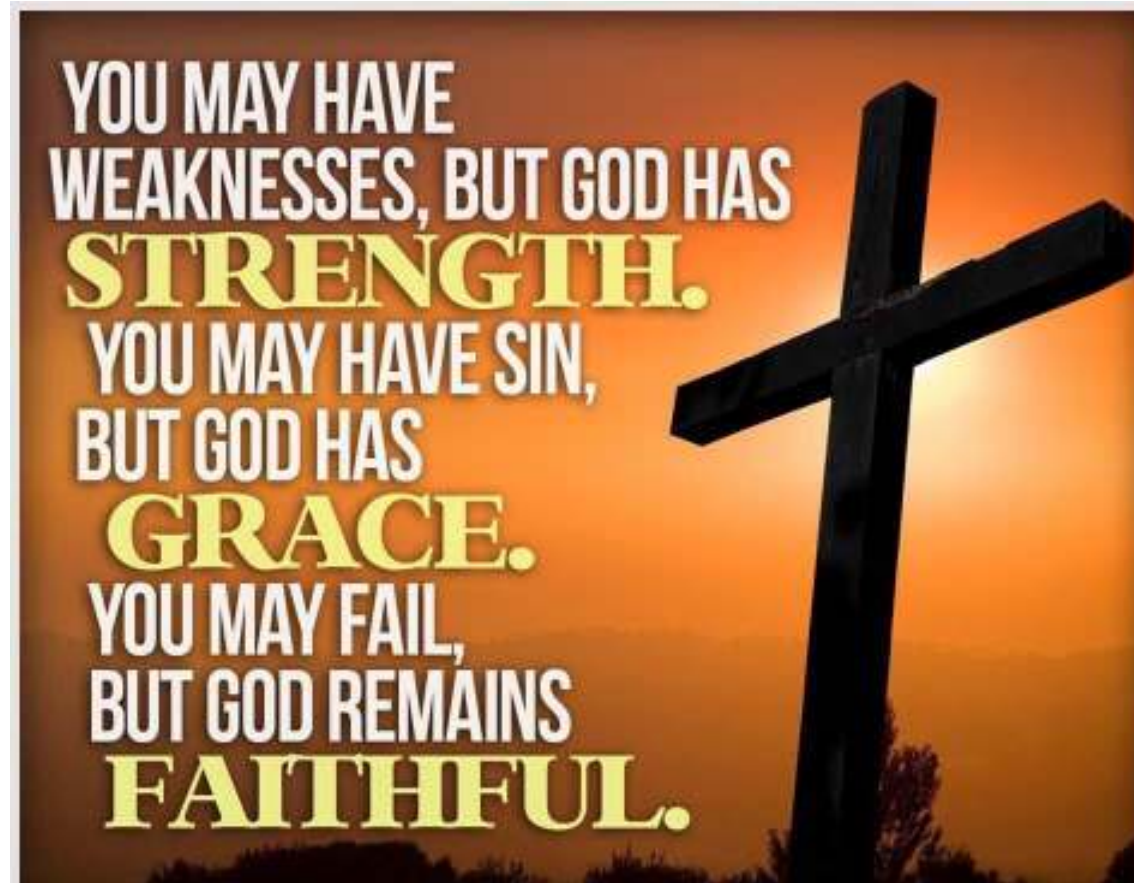
