LOVE CHAPEL IN NEED OF VOLUNTEERS

Love Chapel is a member of the Ecumenical Assembly. This group of churches oversees operations at Brighter Days (local temporary housing), Hot Meals (free evening meals), and the local Food Pantry. Last month we provided housing for 78 individuals (an average of 30 per night), food for 1057 households, and a hot evening meal every night of the week. In addition, 61 individuals received financial assistance from Love Chapel over the last month. The addition of Brighter Days increased the staff budget, so we are in need of volunteers to offset that increase.
