LOVE CHAPEL STILL NEEDS VOLUNTEERS

Our church is a member of the Ecumenical Assembly. This group of churches oversees operations at Brighter Days (emergency housing), Hot Meals (free evening meals), and the local Food Pantry. In March, we provided housing for 90 individuals (an average of 34.61 per night). In addition Love Chapel provided groceries for 961 households (roughly 3596 individuals); a hot evening meal is also served every night of the week.
