Dear FBC Friends:

As we move further into Spring and the month of May, I want to use my column to communicate a few ministry information and opportunity items.

I'm delighted that we will have a summer ministry intern – our own Reilly Jones – joining our ministry staff from May 26 – June 29. Reilly is a student at Franklin College studying business, and, in particular, non-profit management. She will be giving us 15-20 hours per week with a focus on communication and technology aspects of ministry. We envision her assisting myself, as well as a few of our ministry areas, in greater utilization of social media and other digital platforms to support and enhance ministry. Welcome Reilly!

The Latino-Anglo Bridgebuilders (LAB) initiative of American Baptist Churches of Indiana-Kentucky is an opportunity for growth and understanding that I hope First Baptist might consider participating in. This initiative brings together members of Latino and Anglo congregations for dialogue, helping us reach across the chasm of culture and language to build relationships based on our common faith. Three additional meetings of the initiative are scheduled for April 27 (Greenwood FBC), June 15, and July 27. I feel this is an important opportunity for us as Christ followers in today's culture. If you are interested in participating with me in this initiative, please let me know. It will be much more powerful if it is shared by lay leaders and not just pastoral staff.

In April I invited our FBC Worship Planning Team to think with me about a summer preaching series that might be beneficial to the congregation. While I continue to give thought and prayer to their good suggestions, one recommendation that I wish to announce and invite you to participate in is what we are calling "Ask Pastor Dan." Here's the idea and ground rules I'd like to establish for the Ask Pastor Dan series:

- 1. Congregation members and participants can pose a faith related question to me that they would like to hear addressed in a sermon. This might be something biblical, a current event and how Christ followers can respond, or a faith question that you've been thinking about.
- 2. Send me your question by email: dcash@fbccolumbus.org or in written form (USPS mail or through my church mailbox). You must sign your name to the submission as I will not address anonymous questions. All submissions should be turned in by the end of May.
- 3. I will pray through and consider the questions that are submitted and pick one Sunday in July, August, and September on which to address 3 of the questions, or some combination thereof that have been submitted.

Finally, I want to invite your prayers for our Worship Pastor Search Team. They are doing good and important work. Let's keep this search before the Lord in prayer.


