

MEN OF FAITH BIBLE STUDY GROUP RESUMES

The Men of Faith bible study group will resume for our Fall semester on Friday, Aug. 9. Men of Faith meets on Fridays at 6:15 a.m. in the private dining room at Four Seasons Retirement Community (1901 Taylor Rd., Columbus 47203).

Our Fall study, led by Pastor Dan Cash and Dr. Bill Griffith is titled, *Between a Rock and a Hard Place*. This phrase, "between a rock and a hard place" identifies being faced with a situation where a decision has to be made with two choices available, both of which are unsatisfactory options. Life and faith formation often presents us with these kinds of situations. We will be focusing on several scripture passages that offer insight and opportunity for study and discussion around just these kinds of situations.

A member study guide is available for all those who wish to participate and can be picked up on the back ledge of the sanctuary, or in the church office. All men are invited to join the Men of Faith group. The beginning of a new study topic is a great time to join.

Memorial Baptist Church, our sister American Baptist congregation in Columbus, will be joining us for worship. LOVE CHAPEL

Our church is a member of the Ecumenical Assembly. This group of churches oversees operations at Brighter Days (local temporary housing), Hot Meals (free evening meals), and the local Food Pantry. Last month we provided housing for 95 individuals (an average of 35 per night), food for 1,079 households, and a hot evening meal every night of the week. In addition, 72 individuals received financial assistance from Love Chapel over the last month. The addition of Brighter Days increased the staff budget, meaning we are in need of volunteers to offset that increase. If you are able and willing to help, the Volunteer Orientation is at 311 Center Street on the first Thursday of the month at 5:30pm and the second and fourth Monday of each month at 12:30pm.
