## The Names of Jesus 2019 Advent Series

#### Dear Friends of First Baptist:

I greet you in the name of lesus our Lord. This year during the Season of Advent we will be reconnecting with some of the names of Jesus that are found in the Scriptures. I've chosen seven names for the season, which we will expand a bit before and after Advent. Did you know that there are many, many more names for lesus than just these seven? One resource I looked at shared 56 different names by which our Lord is called. That's how perfect and complete Jesus is – it takes all those names to try and begin to describe him.

Maybe you have your favorite name for Jesus. Do you prefer "Emmanuel"? "The Good Shepherd"? How about the "I Am"? Did you know that Jesus most often referred to himself as "The Son of Man"? Do you know what "the Christ" or "Christos" means? Clue: it is not a last name or surname.

Names are important in the Bible, and they are important in life. What you call someone helps determine your relationship with that one. I look forward to worshipping with you during Advent and discovering more about these names as we prepare ourselves for Christmas. Here's a preview of the Sundays and names to come:


