Dear Friends at First Baptist:

Happy New Year! Can you believe it's 2020? There are several things I want to share with you in this first column of the new year:

First, please join me in expressing our gratitude to Pastor David Brown for his past 10 months of leadership and ministry among us. We have come to know and love David and Susan but knew his time at First Baptist was always an "interim" assignment. The Browns will conclude their ministry with us on Sunday, January 12. They will next begin several weeks as short-term volunteer missionaries with International Ministries (ABCUSA) in the Dominican Republic.

Pastor David will be preaching on Jan. 12 and we will be sure to have a time of appreciation after worship so you can wish him and Susan well on their next adventure. Personally, David has become a dear friend as well as trusted colleague in ministry. I will miss the easy collegiality with which we shared ministry. I wish him and Susan God speed and rich blessings.

Meanwhile, the worship leader search continues at First Baptist, and so will worship and music in this continued interim period through lay leadership and our music ministry instrumental staff.

Second, as we turn the calendar into 2020 I'm aware (how could you not be?) that this will be another contentious presidential election year in our country. To that end I'm asking that you join me in participating in an initiative called Golden Rule 2020: A Call for Dignity and Respect in Politics. Supported by American Baptist Churches USA, this initiative calls for: . . . Christians with different theological and political views . . to . . . come together to express concern about the polarization and incivility that is tearing our country apart.

The Golden Rule 2020 support statement reads: We believe that we can find guidance through this national dilemma in the teachings of Jesus. In particular, we believe that Jesus' command to "do unto others as you would have them do unto you" should be taken seriously by Christians who engage in political activity. We also believe that if enough people follow this "Golden Rule" principle, it will help generate the respect and civility we so desperately need in our country.

How can we participate? Congregations and individuals (can) do two things: 1) pray for the healing of the divisions in our country, and 2) promote the use of the Golden Rule in our own political discussions and election activities in 2020.

As your pastor I'm asking you to join me in living into and up to this Golden Rule in this election year!



Many member and participating churches, together with the community at large, support those with emergency needs through Love Chapel. First Baptist is one of the initial churches who started this ministry and our members and their support are important to the function of Love Chapel.

Some of the services they offer include emergency food, emergency shelter, client follow-up and outreach, medication assistance through the Medication Assistance Program, job search and referrals, financial assistance for rent, utilities, and GED testing, holiday food baskets, and prayer and chaplaincy ministry.

January is our turn to help fill the food pantry. We solicit cash and shop for the needed items and deliver them to the pantry. Will you help?
