

FBC is one of the initial churches who started this ministry, and our members and their support are important to the function of Love Chapel. Some of the services they offer include: emergency food, emergency shelter, client follow-up and outreach, medication assistance through the Medication Assistance Program, job search and referrals, financial assistance for rent, utilities, and GED testing, holiday food baskets, and prayer and chaplaincy ministry.
