First Baptist Church Foundation Scholarship

First Baptist Church of Columbus Indiana Foundation has established a scholarship fund to assist members going to college. The scholarship is funded by an endowment that is designed to use the income to fund at least one scholarship each year. The scholarship application must be submitted by April 1st. The selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the directors of the Foundation.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- 1. All applicants must turn in a completed Scholarship Application.
- 2. All applicants must be an active and participating member of First Baptist Church, Columbus, Indiana. Active and participating means being active in one or more than one of the church's activities (i.e., regular worship services, youth activities, Sunday School classes, various ministry teams, etc.). This information will be of major importance in awarding the scholarships.
- 3. All applicants must be or plan to be a full-time undergraduate student. Full-time status must be maintained the entire year at the same college or university you will be attending when applying for this scholarship.
- 4. All applicants must have a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale or a 3.0 on a 5.0 grading scale. A copy of your official grade report or transcript must be submitted. First time applicants must submit a copy of their high school grade report.
- All applicants must be accepted to an accredited college or university. An acceptance letter from the attending school must be submitted by all first time applicants or transferring students.
- 6. Recipients of the E. Don Tull Scholarship are not eligible for this award in the same year.
- 7. The award will be made directly to the recipient and is to be used to help meet educational expenses for the purposes stated on the application. If for some reason the recipient does not continue with the educational program that year, it is expected that the award will be returned to the Foundation.
