



PAST

The First Baptist Church of Columbus, Indiana was organized January 30, 1852. In August, 1852, the Church was received into the Flat Rock Association. Later this association would become a part of the Indiana Baptist Convention and the American Baptist Convention.

A total of 38 ministers have served the Church from its inception to this present time. The Rev. Mr. J. W. Robinson was the first pastor and served for the sum of \$150.00 per year. The shortest pastorate was 6 months, and the longest was that of George T. King, 14 1/2 years.

The first meeting was held in the Presbyterian Church then located at Third and Franklin Streets. After some moving from place to place, in the year 1854, the present property was purchased at a cost of \$260.00. The first building was completed in 1855 at a total cost of \$3,000.00. In the year 1886, a beautiful new front was added at a cost of \$4,000.00. The old part of the building was torn down in 1892, and a new building stood in its place. It was dedicated on March 27, 1893. This brought the value of the property, building and furnishings to an estimated \$20,000.

In 1928, the front of the Church was remodeled at a cost of \$9,100.00. A fourth remodeling was carried out in 1948 - 49 with the dedication on April 8, 1949. This time the cost was approximately \$33,000.00.



PRESENT

As this is being written, the final touches are being made to the contract between First Baptist Church and Repp and Mundt. That contract was approved by the congregation on April 14, 1964. In essence, it binds the congregation to the erection of a new church at a total cost of \$556,000.00. This church will be the result of some six or seven years of planning and praying and giving.



FUTURE

The new Church will be located in the north side of the Fairlawn area of our city. The property consists of approximately six acres, bounded on three side by streets. Immediately to the east, a new elementary school is to be erected. Across the street, northeast, a new city park is planned. We believe God has had a large part in making such an ideal location possible. Truly, our future is as bright as the promises of God.

We look forward to the day when we shall have adequate space and equipment for our Church school. We are anxious to be able to have the two Sunday morning congregations together once more in one service of worship. Adequate parking and outdoor areas for the children are also soon to be realized. However, we know that all of this is without meaning if it does not contribute to a greater witness of the saving grace of God in Jesus Christ.
