Dear Church Family,

As we turn the page into June, we continue our sermon series, *Emotionally Healthy Discipleship*, based on the book by Pete Scazzero. I hope it's been both encouraging and challenging for you. The aim of this series isn't just to offer helpful ideas, but to help us recognize the deeper work the Holy Spirit wants to do in our lives. As we grow in spiritual maturity, we're invited to consider what it means to be shaped from the inside out, learning to live with greater self-awareness, deeper trust, and growing faith in how we relate to God and others.

We just wrapped up our Men of Faith and L.I.G.H.T. Bible studies for summer break. It's been a full year of good conversations, growing friendships, and meaningful time in Scripture. As summer approaches, we naturally shift into a different rhythm. There's space for rest, travel, and a little more breathing room. But I'd encourage you not to disconnect from your walk with Christ. Lamentations 3:22–23 reminds us that, "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."

Whatever the season, God is at work—faithful, steady, present. Lately, I've been thinking about how easy it is to live distracted. We hurry through our routines, fill our days with tasks, and sometimes miss the quiet work of God that's happening all around us. Summer can have a way of slowing us down, just enough, to notice again.

Take time to pay attention. Not just to what needs to be done, but to where God might be moving; maybe in a conversation with a neighbor, a moment of quiet, or a prayer you didn't expect to pray. You don't have to do anything flashy, just stay open, grounded, and willing to be led by the Spirit in your life. The Spirit is present. Let's be people who notice.

# Our Graduates


